a) Eligibility for Admission to the B.Ed., programme Candidate shall be eligible for the Degree of Bachelor of Education, those who has obtained B.A or B.Sc., or a Post Graduate degree from any recognized University. The candidate should have secured minimum 50% marks in the part III of the UG Degree as per the G.O. of Tamil Nadu Government for admitting students in B.Ed. Programme.

b) Duration of the programme and medium of instruction

The duration of study for B.Ed. programme is two academic years. The college works with a minimum of six hours per day. Working hours between 9.00 A.M. to 4.00 P.M.

Duration for school internship shall be for a period of 4 weeks for the first year and 16 weeks for the second year. English shall be the medium of instruction. Student teachers may opt either English or Tamil medium for teaching practice & theory examination.

Theory Course of Study: B.Ed.

The B.Ed. Degree programme shall consist of the perspectives in education, curriculum and pedagogic studies, Enhancing professional capabilities and Practical.

M.Ed. Programme:

• Eligibility for Admission:

The Candidate shall be admitted to the M.Ed., programme those who had passed in UG degree examination in Education (B.Ed) from any recognized university.

The duration of study for M.Ed. programme is two academic years.
